

## Coronavirus – entry to Italy - Digital Passenger Locator Form (dPLF)

From the 24.05.21, every person entering in Italy has to fill in the Passenger Locator Form (dPLF) following the instructions below:

- connect to the site: <https://app.euplf.eu/#/>
- follow the guided procedure to access the dPLF
- choose "Italy" as the country of destination
- register on the site by creating a personal account with username and password (you need to do it only the first time)
- confirm the account via the link arrived at the email address indicated (it is necessary to do this only the first time)
- fill in and send the dPLF following the guided procedure.

Once the form has been sent, the passenger will receive the dPLF in pdf format and QRcode at the email address indicated during registration, which he must show directly from his smartphone (in digital format) upon boarding. Alternatively, the passenger will be able to print a copy of the dPLF to show upon boarding.

A form must be completed for each adult passenger; in the event of the presence of minors, the latter can be registered in the accompanying adult form.

Furthermore, it is mandatory to present the green Covid-19 certification, which shows that, in the forty-eight (48) hours prior to entering the national territory, a molecular or antigenic test has been carried out by means of a swab and the result is negative (compulsory even if you are already vaccinated).
